

Record of Proceedings – September 8, 2025
Washington Township Trustees, Warren County, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Jason Fisher. With Trustee Scott Hagemeyer, Fiscal Officer, Sharon Coffman, and Road Supervisor Allen Stanforth present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of August 25, 2025 were mailed to the Trustees prior to the meeting for review. Warrants 12684 through 12687 totaling \$3003.78 were presented for approval.

A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer to approve the minutes for the August 25, 2025 regular meeting, Mr. Fisher seconded. Mr. Fisher, aye; Mr. Hagemeyer, aye. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Mr. Hagemeyer asked Ms. Coffman if the reply had been sent to the Warren County Auditors Office concerning our plan of action for using carryover money that exceeds 100% of annual revenue. Ms. Coffman stated the letter had been sent. She asked that they let us know if they need anything further.
- Mr. Fisher reported that the Wayne Township Trustees voted to accept the Fire and EMS Coverage 2-year Contract for a portion of our Township that Township Administrator Gus Edwards had presented to us at our last meeting. The new contract will take effect January 1, 2026.
- Mr. Fisher stated that he had sent an email to Jonathan Arroyo from the Yak Shack letting him know that the group that came to one of our past meetings talking about Little Miami River was Little Miami Conservancy. Jonathan attended our last meeting and asked for info about groups he could possibly join that would help in cleaning and preserving the Little Miami River.
- Mr. Hagemeyer said the CWJFD Board had met on Sept 4, 2025 with the insurance agent regarding cost of the policy specific to flood insurance coverage. The current policy has \$1,000,000.00 worth of coverage with a \$1000.00 deductible, which is impossible to beat in a policy, however that is a higher policy amount than they really need. The Board is revisiting possibly having a smaller maximum pay out and also possibly a higher deductible amount.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Mr. Fisher stated that the Warren County Township Association Meeting is September 18, 2025 at 6:00 PM at Union Township.

- Mr. Fisher read a Thank you card from Ms. Betsy Jayne thanking everyone for all the work that was done helping Susan Case place a marker for Hattie Fryer at the Olive Branch Cemetery.
- Mr. Fisher reported that the Warren County Engineer's Office has announced that the intersection of Oregonia Road and Corwin Road will be closed beginning September 15, 2025 for repairs to a culvert and slip replacement, but will open the roads during the evenings on the week prior to and the weekend of the Hillclimb to accommodate all the traffic the event brings.
- Mr. Hagemeyer said that the Warren County Fairgrounds is possibly being sold to the City of Lebanon.
- There being no further business, a motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mr. Fisher to adjourn the meeting at 7:13 PM.
